Acupuncture has wide range of effect on diseases and health; however it must be used with following facts in mind.

- 1 It has major domain over treatment of PAIN, but basic knowledge of that particular disease in terms of anatomy, physiology and pathology causing pain **MUST** be understood before treatment.
- 2 If **BETTER** and alternative treatment of disease being treated is available, acupuncture should not be used.
- 3 If no other effective treatment is available for the disease, acupuncture can be tried with full explanation to patients about **CONSEQUENCES**.
- 4 **NO** false claim of treating any disease or assurance of results is made to patients.
- 5 Acupuncture is just **ONE PART** of full treatment; therefore other modalities must be explained to patient.
